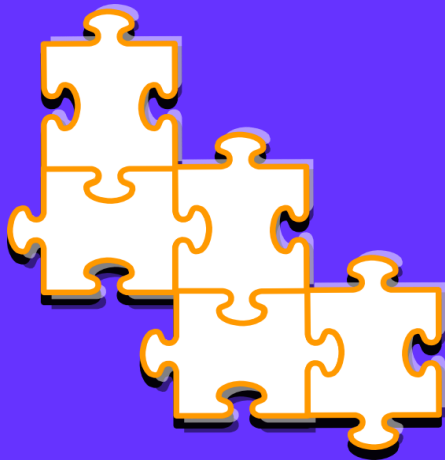

**Teaching Verbal Behavior:
Introducing & Expanding the Functional

The purpose of this workshop is to introduce Verbal Behavior (VB) and associated instructional methods based on ABA to teachers that work with students on the spectrum or other developmental disabilities.

Included in the program will be “evidence based” strategies, demonstrations, and recommendations that can be implemented in the classroom, support and encourage functional communication, and expand the student’s verbal repertoire. This course is designed to provide an opportunity for teachers to increase their skill set in addressing the many challenges associated with autism, behavioral/emotional disorders, and other developmental disabilities.
